- B. FY 15 Budget Workshop

Council also would like to see the Replacement Fund increased. Mayor Kocurek, Mr. Patton and Department Heads will spend the next week reviewing their budget requests in an effort to put more money back into the Replacement Fund.

Police Chief Caudle explained his current plans are to ask for a new police vehicle, upgrade the tasers and add an evidence locker from the Crime Control and Prevention District.
